

Rules for use of Bocce Courts 11/12/2020

USERS OF THIS FACILITY BEAR THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COMPLIANCE WITH CDC GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19 AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-7 AND SUBSEQUENT ORDERS AND ASSUME THE FULL RISK OF UTILIZING THIS FACILITY, INCLUDING THE RISK OF BEING INFECTED BY THE COVID-19 VIRUS. COPIES OF THESE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS ARE AVAILABLE BY REQUEST AND WILL BE PROVIDED IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

- For all activities, residents cannot arrive early and socially congregate and cannot congregate socially after completion of their use of the amenities. Residents should come on time and leave promptly.
- Residents are required to wear face coverings when checking in to use amenities, during the duration of the Bocce game and upon leaving the courts to protect themselves and other residents.
- Player eligibility requirements
  - Must be a resident of Villaggio
    - No guests
    - No visitors
- <u>Sessions</u>: 2 sessions each day: 9:00 am and 10:30 am seven days per week. Reservations cannot be made for any other time during the day.
  - 9:00 am 10:15 am: Residents confirmed for this session should check in with the Tennis Pro or designated monitor at 8:50 AM at the tennis gazebo.
  - 10:30 am 11:45 AM: Residents confirmed for this session should check in with the Tennis Pro or designated monitor at 10:20 AM at the tennis gazebo. Additional sessions will be considered as needed.
  - Temperatures will be taken during check in and must be at or below 100.4 degrees.
- Bocce Balls will be stored near the tennis office and will be given out during check in process.
- Courts will be closed after 11:45 pm daily and will not be available for residents uses.
- Play will be doubles, with a maximum number of players per court limited to 4.
- Players are to sanitize their hands and all equipment before and after play.

- Disinfectant and/or wipes will be placed at each end of each court.
- NO SPECTATORS will be allowed.
- If the courts are wet, play will be suspended until further notice.
- All play will be at the sole risk of each player.
- Reservations: Must book time slot with Association via this Reopening website reservation form starting Sunday and ending Wednesday the week prior to the week you are requesting a reservation for. Reservations will be closed out on Wednesdays at midnight for the following week. Reservation schedules will be posted under Athletic Activities Schedules under the Athletic Activities tab on Fridays on the Villaggio website.
  - The staff will try to accommodate time choices (if unable to, they will do a drawing for each time slot). Bumping will be rotated so each resident has a chance to get their first choice.
- No walk-ons. Players can call the Amenity Hotline at 561-967-6814 option 1 to see if there are any openings on a daily basis.
- Player Responsibilities:
  - Take temperature prior to coming to courts. If exhibiting any coronavirus symptoms (respiratory illness with fever, cough, difficulty breathing) do not play. Vulnerable individuals with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity and asthma and those whose immune system is compromised are advised not to play.
  - •Assert that you have had no contact with anyone with coronavirus within 14 days
- Bring hand sanitizer to court (use prior to play and after play or any time after you sneeze)
- Maintain social distancing at 6 feet or beyond at all times
- Avoid touching your face
- Bring own drinks to court (fountains will be non-functional). The ice/water machine near the tennis pro office will be open but residents must bring their own cup or bottle.
- Residents are recommended to use restroom at home prior to coming to the court. The single bathroom near the tennis pro office will be opened and will be cleaned regularly by our cleaning staff.
- Arrive as close to your scheduled starting time (within 10 minutes)
- Leave courts promptly when your session ends.

- No socializing or hanging around courts.
- Cleaning Staff will disinfect high touch areas, chairs, etc. after each group plays. A log will be kept keeping track of this disinfection schedule.
- Board members and/or staff will make spot checks to assure compliance with all temporary emergency procedures. Violation of the rules of play will result in loss of use of the bocce courts for a period of time to be determined by the General Manager and may result in a notice of violation with fines.
