Residents can register to vote, make changes to an existing registration, request a Vote By Mail ballot on-line or in person at any SOE office. Locations of satellite offices are on the website.

Voters must request a Vote By Mail ballot by October 24th. However, it is best to do so as soon as possible and if requesting it late, it is best to go in-person. Vote By Mail ballots for the General Election will start going out September 24th.

If your friends and neighbors have received theirs but you have not, please contact the Supervisor's office and/or check the status of your ballot on-line. This is easy to do.

Vote By Mail ballots can be mailed, dropped off in person during business hours at any SOE office, deposited in the secure 24-hour drop-box at the Main Office, or dropped at any early voting site in Palm Beach County once Early Voting has begun. Early Voting locations will be posted on the website 30 days prior to the election. If you choose to vote early in-person and have received a mail in ballot, please bring that ballot with you to the polls.

There will be NO in-person voting on Monday, November 2nd. On that day, you can drop your VBM ballot only at any SOE office or the drop-box at the main office. If you plan to mail your ballot, please leave sufficient time for delivery. Also, if your ballot is received in a timely manner, the Supervisor's office will have time to contact you if there is an issue with your ballot. Please make sure all your contact information is up to date.

You can NOT drop a VBM ballot at your regular polling location on Election Day. On Election Day, if you plan to vote in-person but have a mail-in ballot, bring that ballot with you when you go to vote. If you want to use that ballot on Election Day, you must drop it at any SOE office or in the drop box at the main office. It must be at the SOE office before the polls close.

Vote By Mail is safe & secure. You can track the status of your ballot on-line. It will show when a ballot is mailed to you, when it is received by the SOE, and finally, after the polls close, when it has been counted.
