



Rules for use of Outdoor Pool and Water Aerobics Classes

USERS OF THIS FACILITY BEAR THE RESPONSIBILITY OF COMPLIANCE WITH CDC GUIDELINES FOR COVID-19 AND THE PALM BEACH COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDER 2020-7 AND SUBSEQUENT ORDERS AND ASSUME THE FULL RISK OF UTILIZING THIS FACILITY, INCLUDING THE RISK OF BEING INFECTED BY THE COVID-19 VIRUS. COPIES OF THESE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS ARE AVAILABLE BY REQUEST AND WILL BE PROVIDED IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

- For all activities, residents cannot arrive early and socially congregate and cannot congregate socially after completion of their use of the amenities. Residents should come on time and leave promptly.
- Residents who have reserved spots for water aerobics are not allowed to remain at the pool after class unless they have also made a reservation to use the pool during that morning session.
- Residents are required to wear face coverings when checking in to use amenities to protect the staff. Face masks do not have to be worn while enjoying the use of the amenity.
- Residents will enter the outdoor pool area from the south west gate (on the lake side). You CAN NOT enter through the front door of the clubhouse or the north pool gate on the side of the building where the Arts & Crafts Room is. There will be a doorbell on the gate. Please ring the doorbell using your elbow when you arrive for your confirmed scheduled reservation and the pool attendant will meet you at the gate.
- Upright seating will be placed on the pool deck for residents while using the outdoor pool. The chairs will be disinfected after each session. Residents are still able to bring their own chairs if they prefer. Please remember that chairs need to be spaced 8 feet apart from other households.
- Residents must maintain at least 6 feet apart for social distancing from other pool guests that are not from the same household. Chairs should be placed at least 8 feet apart for residents not from the same household to allow for a 2 foot buffer when getting in and out of the chair.

The north-west stairs near the cabana by the spa will be designated for entry into the pool and the café side stairs will be designated for exit. The areas will be marked to avoid confusion.

- Handrails must be wiped after each use. Disinfectant wipes will be provided on the edge of the pool near the stairs along with a trash can. Residents are required to wipe the handrail when they enter and exit the pool. Please dispose of wipe in provided trash can.
- Residents should bring their own non-glass drinks or can use the ice/water machine with the use of their own cup/bottle. Cups will not be provided.
- The spa in the outdoor pool area will be open during each outdoor pool session. Residents may use the spa under the following conditions:
 - A resident must sign up for an outdoor pool session to use the spa
 - No more than 2 residents are allowed in the spa at a time and social distancing must be maintained
 - Time in the spa is limited to 15 minutes
- The cabana bathrooms will be opened and will be cleaned regularly during open pool hours.

HOMEOWNER RESPONSIBILITY

Take temperature prior to coming to pool. If exhibiting any coronavirus symptoms (respiratory illness with fever, cough, difficulty breathing) do not play. Vulnerable individuals with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity and asthma and those whose immune system is compromised are advised not to use the pool at this time.

- Assert that you have had no contact with anyone with coronavirus within 14-days
- Bring hand sanitizer to pool (use prior to play and after play or any time after you sneeze)
- Wear mask at minimum from parking lot to pool door and while waiting online to gain entry.
- Wearing mask during use of pool is optional
- Practice social distancing at 6 feet or beyond at all times.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Bring your own chair and towel.
- Bring own drinks to pool (fountains will be non-functional). The ice/water machine near the cabana bathrooms will be open but residents must bring their own cup or bottle. Entry to the café and ordering of food from the pool deck is prohibited.
- Residents are recommended to use restroom at home prior to coming to the court. The cabana bathrooms will be opened and will be cleaned regularly by the cleaning staff.
